Faith Builders allows children to engage in play with church friends in a loving environment. Children will learn about God's love through crafts, stories, and laughter.

Not ready to sit through an entire service? No worries. Godly Play (1st-2nd Grade) is available during the 11:00 service. Children will join their families in the sanctuary and then be escorted by a volunteer to room C43 after Children's Moment. Godly Play allows our younger church to create relationships and memories with church friends. When the weather is nice, Godly play goes outdoors to the playground. Parents can access the playground from the Godly Play Room (C43).

St. Stephen's offers many ways for families to worship and fellowship on Sunday mornings.

9:00 a.m. Contemporary Service offers a faster-paced worship experience including today's Christian music led by our very own Source Band. Children are welcome to worship alongside their families or children 4 years old-Kindergarten can attend Faith Builders. Children wishing to attend Faith Builders will be escorted by a volunteer at the conclusion of Children's Moment. Parents may pick up their child after the service in Room C44.

10:00 a.m. Sunday School is open to all. Children will check in at the kiosk at the Preschool entrance and be then escorted to their classroom by a parent. Children can be picked up at 10:50 a.m. Parents are encouraged to also attend a Sunday School class. Don't know where to begin? Try Christian Parenting in Room C41. The class covers the same topic your child is studying.

11:00 a.m. Traditional Service offers a completely traditional worship experience with your favorite hymns from the United Methodist Hymnal. Children are welcome to worship alongside their families or children may attend Faith Builder (4 years old-Kindergarten) and Godly Play (1st-2nd grades). Children wishing to attend Faith Builders or Godly Play will be escorted to these programs at the conclusion of Children's Moment by a volunteer. Children may be picked up at the end of the service in Room C44 Faith Builders and C43 Godly Play.

Nursery is available for children age 0-3 years. Our caring, experienced staff will share the love of God with your child while you worship. Our Nursery is located in Room C46.

Family Break Room, located around the corner (to your right when exiting the sanctuary), is designed to allow parents to rock or play with their child while watching and listening to the service through a window. It's a bit tricky to find. Please ask an usher or greeter - they like to help.

CROP Hunger Walk: On November 6, join the St. Stephen's team of walkers for the Burke/Fairfax CROP Hunger Walk! CROP Hunger Walks across the country raise awareness and funds to provide food and fight hunger in the U.S. and around the world.
